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PROGRAM NOTES

In Years 1 and 2, students need to double count at least two 4 credits courses or three 3 credits courses to complete Gen Ed in 44 credits. Generally students can find some courses in Goal Areas 5 or 6 that also count for Area 7; some courses in Areas 3, 5, or 6 that also count for Area 9, and some courses in Goal Areas 3 or 5 that also count for Area 10. When goal areas are already fulfilled by double-counting, students can proceed to courses later in the program. Double counted courses can only be counted once toward the 44 cr, so if students finish all the goal areas but do not have 44 cr in gen ed, they must take additional gen ed credits from any area.
