Program Description:

Students practice their art form in a variety of different contexts ranging from performance, to choreography, to teaching, to cultural and historical studies in dance. The Private Studio Teaching Emphasis is a 44 credit degree program that requires a minor in Marketing. Students select the "Non-College of Business" Major option in the minor. This program of students prepares students to become private studio owners with substantial preparation in dance coupled with knowledge about how to market and manage a small business.
