Program Description:

Studying French provides insight into the literature and culture of France and other French-speaking countries. It also gives students a knowledge of language that enables them to work and travel in areas of the world where French is spoken. To facilitate these

goals, the department sponsors a summer program in France. Students choosing to take advantage of this study-abroad opportunity, or who acquire language experience on their own initiative, may receive credit if arrangements are made in advance.

You are expected to meet with your advisor on a regular basis to ensure courses are taken in an order that will lead to successful completion of the degree.

- 1. All major courses must be taken for credit and the student must receive a grade of C or better (C minus does not count).
- 2. Study Abroad is highly recommended. See you advisor for information.
- 3. Students must take two Diverse Cultures courses from two different disciplines Either one Purple and one Gold, or two Purple as part of their General Education requirements.
- 4. In General Education goal areas where two courses are required, courses must be from different disciplines.
- 5. Students must take two Writing Intensive courses.
